# ASSEMBLY STEPS

## STEP 1 – INSTALL THE CASTERS

- Turn each cabinet upside down.
- Install all casters to the bottom of the cabinets.
- Ensure all casters are securely tightened.

## STEP 2 – ASSEMBLE THE CABINETS

- Position the left and right cabinets.
- Connect the center support panels using the M6×25 Connector Screws (Part 3).
- Secure each connection with the M6×12 Cap Nuts (Part 4) using the M4 Hexagonal Wrench (Part 2).

## STEP 3 – INSTALL THE DUST COLLECTOR

- Insert the Vacuum Cleaner (Part 5) into the countertop opening.
- Place the Filter Panel (Part 6) on top of the dust collector.

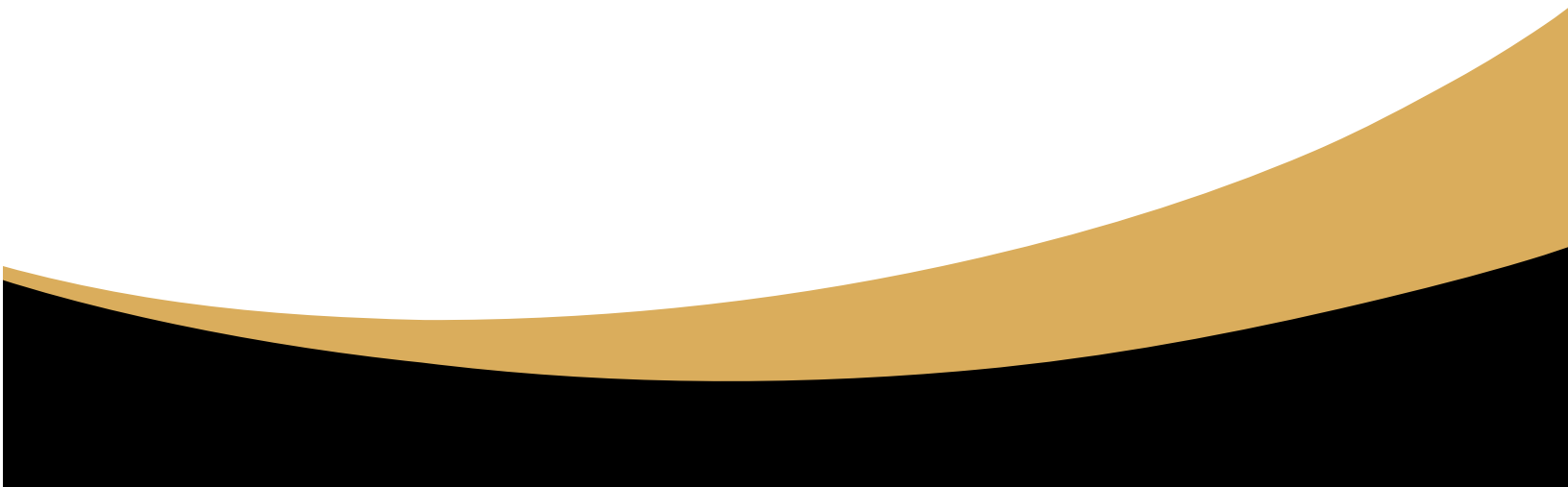
## STEP 4 – INSTALL THE ARM REST PAD

- Insert the Large Bushing Insert (Part 9) and Small Bushing Insert (Part 10) into the countertop.
- Place the Hand Rest Pad (Part 8) onto the installed bushings.

## STEP 5 – CONNECT THE POWER ADAPTER

- Place the Power Adapter (Part 7) inside the cabinet as shown.
- Connect the power cable to the dust collector.
- Route the cable neatly and plug the adapter into a DC 24V power outlet.

## STEP 6 – FINAL INSPECTION

- Verify that all screws are tightened securely.
  - Check that all casters roll smoothly.
  - Test the dust collector to ensure it operates properly.
  - Confirm the workstation is stable before use.

## FINAL CHECKS

- Confirm all screws are tight and the top is level.
- Ensure drawers/doors open smoothly and casters roll freely.
- Wipe away fingerprints and debris with a soft cloth.

## CARE & USE

- Avoid standing or sitting on the top.
- Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap; do not use abrasives.
- Periodically re-check screw tightness, especially after the first week of use or relocation.
- If anything doesn't align as expected, loosen, realign, and retighten rather than forcing parts together. For support, contact your seller with your model number and a photo of the hardware layout.
