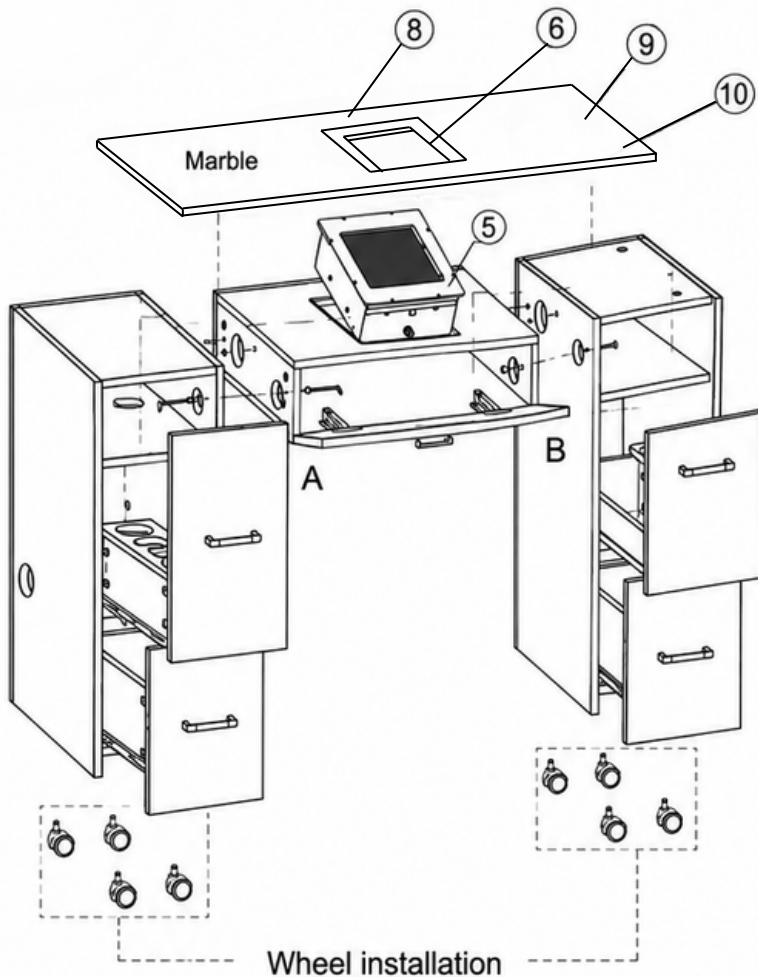
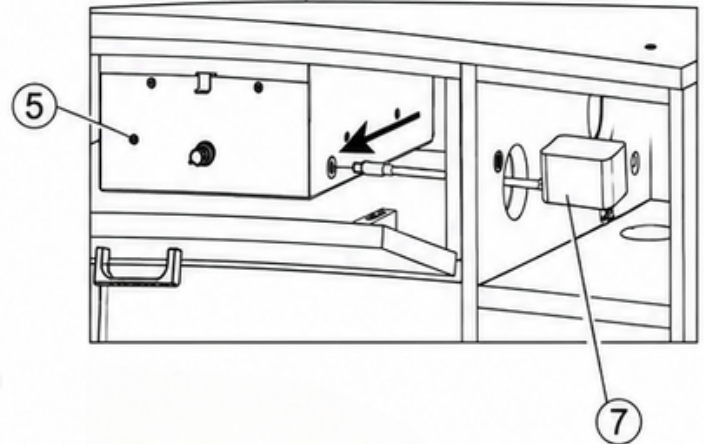

BILL OF MATERIALS

①		Wheel no lock	8 PCS
②		Hexagonal wrench (M4)	2 PCS
③		Connector Screw (M6 x 25)	6 PCS
④		Screw Tap (Φ6 x 12)	6 PCS
⑤		Vacuum cleaner	1 PCS
⑥		Panels	1 PCS
⑦		Power Adapter	1 PCS

ASSEMBLY STEPS

STEP 1 – INSTALL THE CASTERS

Attach all 8 casters to the bottom of the cabinet.
Press each caster firmly into the mounting holes until fully secured.

STEP 2 – ASSEMBLE CONNECTOR A & B

Insert the connector screws (Part ③) into the side panels.

Use the supplied hex wrench (Part ②) to tighten the screws.

Secure each connector with the screw caps (Part ④).

STEP 3 – INSTALL THE DUST COLLECTOR

Place the dust collector (Part ⑤) into the opening on the countertop.

Install the filter panel (Part ⑥) on top.

Secure the unit using the included screws (Part ⑨ & ⑩).

STEP 4 – CONNECT THE POWER ADAPTER

Connect the power adapter (Part ⑦) to the DC 24V IN port inside the cabinet.

Route the cable neatly through the cable opening.

STEP 5 – INSTALL THE HAND REST PAD

Place the hand rest pad (Part ⑧) onto the countertop.

- Adjust to the desired position before use.

FINAL CHECKS

- Table is level; all screws are tight.
- Drawers/doors open smoothly; casters roll freely (engage brakes if fitted).
- Fan is firmly mounted and unobstructed.

USE & CARE

- Plug the fan into a grounded outlet; keep intake clear during operation.
- Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap only; avoid abrasives and solvents.
- Re-check screw tightness after the first week of use and after relocation.
- Do not stand or sit on the tabletop; do not lift the table by the top alone.
